He has successfully implemented community based rehabilitation of the disabled children of all categories (hearing impaired, mentally retarded and multi handicapped) in over 100 villages directly reaching out to over 1000 disabled children, majority of them are now in regular schools pursuing their education and those of the grown up children have been helped/rehabilitated with vocational trainings and economic support with which they have become contributories to themselves and to their families and not being burden to their families.
